

## **BREC Junior Golf Age Policy**

(Approved by the BREC Commission April 27, 2004)

Juniors age 6-17 will be eligible to attend BREC Junior golf clinics.

Juniors age 6-12 will be eligible to play golf anytime at BREC's Clark Park and City Park golf courses under the DIRECT supervision of an adult.

Juniors age 8-12 will be eligible to play golf anytime at any 18-hole BREC golf course under the DIRECT supervision of an adult.

Juniors age 13 and older may play any BREC golf course at anytime without adult supervision.

Juniors under age 8 will not be allowed on any BREC 18-hole golf course or practice facility. This includes riding in a golf cart with an adult or walking the course with an adult.

Juniors under age 6 will not be allowed on any 9-hole BREC golf course or driving range. This includes riding in a golf cart with an adult or walking the course with an adult. One exception to this policy has been granted and that is for the US Kids Golf State Championship held at Beaver Creek. Juniors age 4-12 will be eligible to compete in this tournament due to strict and constant supervision required by US Kids Golf and the course will be closed for adult play.

Juniors age 4-7 are eligible to participate in BREC's Li'l Chipper Program which will test their golf skill and knowledge of golf rules, safety, and etiquette. Successful completion of the Li'l Chipper Program will allow juniors age 4-7 to play BREC golf courses at off-peak times which is one hour after normal posted twilight hours.

Golf course managers have the right to remove junior golfers from any course if they do not follow the proper etiquette and conduct or if they do not show a general knowledge of golf skills and accepted golf practices.

Golf course managers have the right to remove adults from any course if the adults fail in their supervisory duties.

Juniors will be encouraged to attend BREC Junior Golf and First Tee instructional clinics and camps to further their golf skills and to provide them and their parents with a more enjoyable playing experience.
