

Club Golf League (Ages 14 to 18)

Designed for boys and girl golfers in High School wishing to play in a competitive team style program.

- Juniors will be assigned to given teams and will play in matches similar to High School and College Golf Teams; best ball, scramble, and alternate shot formats will be used.
- Special Practice & Orientation Sessions with PGA Pro at the beginning of the season June 26th & 27th. Designed to get players oriented toward match play format.
- Registration to join is \$25 + Uniform cost. Players pay Green Fee at the given course on the day of the match.

Initially, players attend the June 26th and 27th sessions to become ranked and get accustomed to playing with one another in a competitive environment that is primarily similar to High School and College Golf.

During the season, players will be assigned and accumulate points. Beginning with the June 26th & 27th ranking, players will be assigned to teams based on where they are in the points standing. The league works as each player accumulates points and moves up as much as possible in the rankings; as they do they will then be assigned to given teams in the next match. Players may find themselves playing with different teammates at various times in the season based on where they are landing in the points for that next match.

At the end of the season, the top 10 players will form the All-Star team and receive awards. Also, following Match 5, there will be team awards for that match. Basically, players join and play as much as possible and try to move up in the rankings. It is designed to reward the player that attends the most & improves during the season.
