

BREC presents a junior golf team concept

Competitive Golf League

Boys & Girls; 9 to 13 Years Old

This is a junior golf program structured to be played out in a team setting. Each team will have 8 players and will play matches against other teams in a two player scramble format. Designed for young ladies and men, ages 9 to 13 years old, must possess the proficiency to play in a competitive environment much like the PGA Jr League. This league, however, is a BREC sponsored league and operates slightly different than the PGA Jr League; no membership to the PGA Jr League is required. Also, in the PGA JR League teams compete for "flags", in this league points are earned by the number of holes won during a match with the overall point earners winning the League championship. Players younger than 9 will be permitted if they can clearly display they have the ability to compete at this higher level; evaluation days may be established if demand is valid.

There will be two days of Orientation and Practice to prepare the players for competition. There will not be instructional sessions provided, players need to come with the skill sets to get the ball into the air, play from further distances, manage to play independently without much supervision, and able to play a full complement of 9 holes within a 2-hour time frame. Within this orientation, there will also be two structured practice sessions in how to play in this competitive format and prepare for Drive, Chip, and Putt.

Following the Orientation, players will then enter into a week-long series of matches. Parental involvement will be marginal. Players must have their own equipment.
